

## **Rooftop, Crane, Roof-curb, or large equipment Jobsite delivery policy**

This delivery policy applies to both vendor direct and our truck or trailer delivery.

1. Our quoted free freight allowed price will include 1.5 hours for a rooftop delivery.
  - a. All other time will be billable at \$50 per half hour.
2. Delivery time will start at the later of these 2 events:
  - a. The arrival time of the product on a truck or trailer
  - b. The pre-scheduled delivery time
3. The Driver will log his start and finish times and if necessary charges will be billed to customer referencing the job name.
  - a. If we deliver the products the charges will be within 2 days of delivery.
  - b. If it is a vendor direct shipment, charges may not appear for up to 2 months.
4. Scheduled Delivery changes are subject to availability and will be billable at \$100 if changed within 12 hours of original delivery time.
  - a. This is because of the costs of loading and then unloading your order.
5. Scheduled Delivery changes after Our truck has left Our facility are billable at \$50 per half hour until the truck returns to Our facility. Minimum charge is \$100
  - a. This is because of the costs of loading, transporting and then unloading your order.
6. Old Rooftop Removal is available on HVAC Distributors, Inc. Truck or trailer deliveries by request for the following fees:
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> unit
    - i. Coil Included = \$150
    - ii. Coil Removed = \$200
  - b. Every other unit after the 1<sup>st</sup>
    - i. Coil Included = \$50
    - ii. Coil Removed = \$100

\*\*\*We will allow 1 half hour extra for rooftop removal when scheduled

### **Helpful Hints to avoid extra delivery charges:**

- On large jobs where the crane will need to move to get all units up you may need to plan and budget extra charges or plan how to avoid them.
- Schedule the equipment delivery later than the crane – The crane needs time to set-up and get in place.
- Make sure all of your Field Service people are aware of the policy and charges
- Crane or forklift delays will cause delivery delays which will be billable – make sure you are documenting these so you can pass on the charges to the crane company.
- Crane or forklift can unload the new units and place them on the ground in designated areas to be put on the roof later.
- Crane can unload the new units and place on the roof on wood planks to place later.
